Please submit your public comments via email no later than 6:00pm on September 01, 2020.** All comments submitted by email that, if read orally, are three minutes or less shall be read into the record. All comments submitted by email shall be made a part of the public record. If any member of the public has any questions, please contact the **City Clerk at 561-996-6751.**
- If a person decides to appeal any decision made by the Commission with respect to any matter considered at a meeting or hearing, he/she will need a record of the proceedings and for such purpose may need to insure that a verbatim recording of the proceedings is made, which record includes the testimony and evidence upon which the appeal is to be based. (The above notice is required by State Law. Anyone desiring a verbatim transcript shall have the responsibility at his/her own expense to arrange for the recording and transcript).
