(D) Performing


(E) Adjouring/Transforming We as a team have to show leadership.

#### **CROSSROADS MUSEUM & CULTURAL CENTER Fast Facts**

The City of South Bay, founded in 1910, is named for its location at the southern tip of Lake Okeechobee in the heart of South Florida. The city, known as the "crossroads of south Florida at the intersection of two major roads, East-West State Road 80 and North-South U.S. 27.

South Bay and other cities in "the Glades region" of Palm Beach County were founded as agricultural communities due to the rich soil in the area from their proximity to Lake Okeechobee and the Everglades This soil, known as "muck," proved to be perfect for farming vegetables and eventually sugar cane.

The Florida East Coast (FEC) Railroad arrived in South Bay in 1926. Along with the railroad came the Lead to see the Construction of two buildings: a depot and a railroad cottage. The FEC built approximately 100 similar in not identical, depots and cottages along the railroad right of way from Jacksonville to Key West. All were painted what has become known as "Flagler yellow" trimmed in white. Only three cottages exist today.

The region was nearly destroyed by the 1928 hurricane. In South Bay, only five buildings including the FEC Railroad cottage remained standing after the storm. The City of South Bay purchased the cottage 2000 and in 2005 relocated the cottage from its original position on N.W. 4th Street to the South Bay Crossroads Center on US 27.

The two-story cottage is approximately 1,600 square feet. The first floor has four rooms, with a separate kitchen, a working bathroom, and front and rear porches. Upstairs is one large room with a pitched pyramid ceiling and windows on all four elevations. The floors are the original "Dade County Pine."

The South Bay Crossroads Center is a Palm Beach County public park. The facility includes a public pu with a playground and picnic tables, one of 14 entry points for the Lake Okeechobee Scenic Trail with two boat ramps and parking for boaters and hikers, a 72-site RV park, and a 3,000-square-foot community building with a catering kitchen and bathroom facilities
