














Dear Parents/Guardians and Teachers,

Auditions for the Missoula Children's Theatre production of *The Princess and the Pea* will be held on Monday, September 11 at the DOLLY HAND CULTURAL ARTS CENTER. Registration begins at 3:30 PM, with auditions starting at 4:00 PM. There are roles for currently enrolled students ages 5 to 18 years old. Approximately 50-60 local children will be cast to appear in the show with the Missoula Children's Theatre Tour Actor/ Directors. There is no guarantee that everyone who auditions will be cast in the play.

No one will be admitted to the auditions after 4:15pm!



Children wishing to audition should arrive by the scheduled starting time and plan to stay for the entire two-hour session. No advance preparation is necessary. The first rehearsal begins approximately 30 minutes after the auditions.

Rehearsals will be conducted every day (Tuesday through Thursday) from approximately 4:00 PM -8:30 PM at the Dolly Hand Cultural Arts Center. Although not all east members will be needed at every session, those auditioning must have a clear schedule for the entire week, and if selected, be able to attend all rehearsals required for their role. A detailed rehearsal schedule will be distributed at the conclusion of the auditions. Cast members scheduled for the full 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ hours of rehearsal will be asked to bring a sack supper or snack.

The performances will be held on Friday, Sept. 15 at 12PM (closed to the public and parents) and on Saturday, Sept.16 at 11AM for the public and parents. The children will also rehearse on Friday morning prior to the performance. Each student will be given a TLE so that they may be excused from school on Friday. All those cast MUST be available for all rehearsals and performances.

Missoula Children's Theatre is a non-profit organization based in Missoula, Montana. Prior to COVID, nearly 65,000 cast members across the globe each year took to the stage to the delight and applause of their families, friends, community, neighbors and teachers! The residency in Belle Glade is made possible by Palm Beach State College-Glades/Dolly Hand Cultural Arts Center with support from the the H.E. Hill Foundation.

Queridos Padres, Guardianes y Maestros:

Audiciones para la production de La Princesa y el Guisante del Missoula Children's Theater, tendra lugar el Lunes, 11 de Septiembre en el DOLLY HAND CULTURAL ARTS CENTER (DHCAC). La matriculación empezará a las 3:30 PM, y las audiciones empezarán a las 4:00 PM. Hay papeles para estudiantes de todas las edades, desde 5 hasta 18.



Se selecionarán de 50 a 60 niños locales para participar en la obra con los actores y directores del Missoula Children's Theatre. No se puede garantizar que todos los niños que hagan audicion conseguirán un papel en la obra. ¡No se admitira a nadie después de las 4:15 pm!

Los niños que deseen hacer una audición deben de llegar puntualmente y estar dispuestos a quedarse 2 horas. **No hay que hacer ninguna preparación previa**. EL primera ensayo empezará aproximadamente media hora después de terminar las audiciones.

Los ensayos se harán todos los días (Martes a Jueves) desde las 4:00 PM hasta las 8:30 PM en el DHCAC. Aunque no todo los miembros del reparto tendrán que estar en todas las prácticas, los que piensen hacer una audición tienen que tener el horario libre toda la semana, y, si fueran seleccionados, poder asistir a todas los ensayos. Un horario detallado de los ensayos se repartirá al terminar las audiciones. Los niños que tengan un papel en la obra, se le requiere que estén en las practices todas las 4 horas y media, y deben de traer su comida o merienda a los ensayos. Las actuaciones de la obra tendrán lugar el Viernes, 15 de Septiembre a las 12:00 PM (CERRADO PARA EL PUBLICO Y LOS PADRES) y el Sábado, 16 de Septiembre a las 11:00 AM para el publico y los padres. También habrá un ensayo el Viernes en la mañana antes de la actuación. A todos los niños que tengan un papel en la obra se les dará un TLE para justificar su ausencia en la escuela el Viernes. Todos los niños que participen en la obra tienen que estar en todas las actuaciones sin falta.
